

Who are our Governors and what do they do?



Our Local Governing Committee is made up from people from our community, from our schools and from our parent body. The local governing committee meets 5 times every year to discuss the educational performance, financial performance and the future focus of the schools.

Lisa Vyas, our Executive Headteacher is responsible for the day to day management of the Trust schools. Lisa provides information to the Governors to help them develop a strategic focus, to ensure school money is well spent and to ensure that pupils are achieving their targets.





Chris Wills, a local Councillor, is the Chair of our Local Governing Body. Chris was elected as Chair by the committee members. At each meeting, Chris takes the committee through the meeting agenda and invites discussion around each agenda item.
